SCORING METHODS ACCEPTED FOR RANKING IN TN

LISTED BELOW ARE THE ONLY FORMATS FOR SCORING ACCEPTED FOR RANKING IN TN. FOR TOURNAMENTS THAT FAIL TO COMPLY, THE REFEREE AND THE TOURNAMENT ARE SUBJECT TO SUSPENSION. FOR PLAYERS WHO COMPETE IN EVENTS/MATCHES THAT FAIL TO MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS THOSE PLAYERS WILL NOT HAVE THOSE EVENTS/MATCHES INCLUDED IN THEIR RANKING. THESE ARE THE ONLY SCORING FORMATS ACCEPTED FOR NC RANKING FOR ADULTS/SENIORS, NTRP, WHEELCHAIR AND FAMILY EVENTS:

1. Two out of three tie break sets
 2. Two out of three sets with the 10-point match tiebreak used in lieu of the third set. In Adult/Senior and NTRP tournaments the use of the format must be advertised on the online tournament entry blank and on the individual tournament information at www.tennesseetennis.com.
 3. No-Ad scoring may be used as determined by the referee.
- B. NTRP RANKINGS - SINGLES, DOUBLES & MIXED: Players are ranked in Men's and Women's 2.5-5.0 singles and doubles. Mixed Doubles teams are ranked as Mixed Combo 5.0-10.0 Doubles with the players' combined ratings not exceeding the Combined NTRP level and with no more than One (1) point difference in players' NTRP ratings. Doubles & Mixed Doubles points will be counted as team.
1. May participate at a higher level of play than ones' latest NTRP rating, but never lower. For doubles, the team must play at the level of the higher rated partner. Doubles & Mixed Doubles points will be counted individually.
 2. Players with a current rating from the USA League Tennis NTRP Computer Ratings are required to compete at that level or higher for the entire calendar year. A current NTRP Computer Rating is anyone having participated in the USA League Adult, Senior, or Mixed programs and having a Computer rating in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 or 2009. Players without a NTRP rating may self-rate.
 3. Any player disqualified from playing a NTRP level in the USA League Tennis Program is also disqualified from playing that level in NTRP tournaments for the remainder of the year. The newly defined level shall be considered the most current NTRP computer rating for tournament competition.
 4. A player may play at the level indicated by one's current NTRP Computer rating (a 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 or 2009 computer rating) even though playing on a USA League team at a higher level.
 5. NTRP Tournaments will calculate into a player's year end rating as matches played.
 6. Level movement in 2006, upward or downward, as a result of published dynamic NTRP ratings for "early start" USA League Tennis competition will not apply to USTA/NC NTRP tournament competition.
- A. A Round Robin is **required** in all Adult/NTRP Tournaments for all events, singles and doubles, in which there are **4 or fewer** participants.

SCORING METHODS ACCEPTED FOR RANKING IN TN

LISTED BELOW ARE THE ONLY FORMATS FOR SCORING ACCEPTED FOR RANKING IN TN. FOR TOURNAMENTS THAT FAIL TO COMPLY, THE REFEREE AND THE TOURNAMENT ARE SUBJECT TO

SUSPENSION. FOR PLAYERS WHO COMPETE IN EVENTS/MATCHES THAT FAIL TO MEET THESE REQUIREMENTS THOSE PLAYERS WILL NOT HAVE THOSE EVENTS/MATCHES INCLUDED IN THEIR RANKING. THESE ARE THE ONLY SCORING FORMATS ACCEPTED FOR NC RANKING FOR ADULTS/SENIORS, NTRP, WHEELCHAIR AND FAMILY EVENTS:

4. Two out of three tie break sets
