

USTA – Tennessee Policy Adopted by Executive Board of the Board of Directors, October 15, 2011 Regarding Qualification for CDLM grants

The Southern Tennis Association and the USTA-TN jointly fund annual grants to community tennis associations through the Community Development/Local Membership Grant Program.

Effective January 1, 2012, all community tennis associations in Tennessee which receive CDLM grants must observe the following requirements in addition to requirements which already exist.

1. Each community tennis association must be governed by a board of directors which must include at least one Adult League Coordinator (ALC) and at least one Junior Team Tennis Coordinator (JTTC) serving in their coverage area as voting members of the board of directors. The coordinators must attend USTA-TN training and receive approval for qualification by the USTA-TN. The community tennis association must provide its list of board of directors with ALC and JTTC designations to the Executive Director of the USTA-TN on or before December 1, 2011 and December 1 of every year thereafter.
2. Each community tennis association must submit its prospective annual operating budget with its application for CDLM grants on or before December 1, 2011 (and every year thereafter) and must submit its adopted annual operating budget no later than January 31, 2012 (and every year thereafter) to the Cathy Harris, USTA – TN Community Tennis Specialist.
